

REQUEST FOR BID
FOR
ELECTRICAL SERVICE UPGRADE

Douglas Disposal Service, Inc., is formally requesting BIDS from licensed electrical contractors for installation and connection of power upgrade for NV Energy service line extension of a 30 PDM load break transformer, 750 KVA, and to power boxes and equipment at the Douglas County Transfer Station, 901 Pinenut Road, Gardnerville, Nevada.

Installation will include:

In conformance to Exhibit A of Rule 9, Line Extension Agreement No. 44195, between Sierra Pacific Power Company, d/b/a NV Energy and Douglas Disposal, Inc.:

- 1 – 30 PDM transformer pad, 85”x79”x12 “per NV Energy standard,
- Underground trenching, installation and backfill of approximately 150 feet, 4” PVC service conduit,
- Mandrelling conduit and installing a pull line meeting NV Energy requirements, per Exhibit A above,
- Secondary junction enclosures, including sweeps, risers, etc.,
- Pad installation for secondary junction enclosures,
- Routing of electrical wiring and associated conduit to junction enclosures throughout the facility and to conveyor and baler equipment.

Performance Requirements:

In conformance with **Douglas County Transfer Station Service Upgrade plans, by PK Electrical, Inc.** Plans available for review at the address below or via email, upon request.

Adherence to NV Energy gas and electric standards and all Nevada state electrical construction standards. All work must be accomplished in strict accordance with the specifications set forth in the Electric Distribution Guide, Vol. 17, as currently adopted by NV Energy. Contractor will secure copies of the Construction Specification on his or her own behalf.

Description of warranty of work.

Experience with industrial facility electrical installation is required.

Nevada licensing requirements: C02 - Electrical

License must be in good standing with the Nevada State Contractor’s Board and maintain required financial responsibility requirements throughout the term of the project.
